Rock International Golf Inc (RIGI) will host on Sunday July 11, 2010, the First Annual Marilyn Louise Robinson Tournament at Nemaocolin Woodlands Resort in Farmington Pennsylvania. Nemaocolin was named the #8 Resort Spa in the USA and Canada (Travel + Leisure) and the #1 Golf Resort on the East Coast. Nemaocolin played host to the PGA Tour 84 Lumber Classic (2003 – 2006) as well as the qualifying site for many the USGA Amateur Championship events.



The quality of courses will leave you breathless not to mention the proceeds from the tournament will be set aside to grow the Marilyn Louse Robinson Scholarship Endowment Fund managed by the Poise Foundation. Participants of the West Penn Minority Jr. Golf Association (WPMJGA) will benefit from the funds raised from this event and will supplement scholarship funds issued annually by WPMJGA.
